Storm Event Overview:

A storm forecast predicted snowfall in the Gillette area starting Saturday night, December 23, 2023, with more snow expected on Sunday, December 24, 2023. Night and Day crews were placed "on call" for the expected snow. Heavy winds with two to six inches of snow were predicted for the upcoming storm.

Saturday 12/23/2023

On Saturday December 23, 2023, wind speeds rose to 30 mph around 6:00 p.m., bringing with it falling snow. By 6:15 p.m., the snowfall had intensified as the temperature dropped to 28 degrees. At 6:40 p.m., the Gillette Police Department notified the Streets Department that roads were becoming slick. In response, the Streets Department called in the night crew at 6:45 p.m. to clear hazardous road conditions. By 10:00 p.m., temperatures had fallen to 20 degrees with 40 mph wind gusts. The night crew focused on clearing priority routes East, Central, West, Downtown, and Trouble. By 1:00 a.m. Sunday, December 24, 2023, the snow, and winds had subsided, enabling the night crew to clear drifting snow and ice from all routes. They completed operations by 4:00 a.m. after clearing and laying material on roadways, making roadway conditions satisfactory. Between 1-2 inches of snow accumulated during the event. The day crew was not called in to work Sunday morning, December 24, 2023.

Event 3 was closed at 4:00 a.m. Sunday morning, December 24, 2023.


The forecast overestimated the amount of snowfall; high winds caused the storm to pass through Gillette rapidly, leading to far less snow accumulation and fewer related problems than predicted.
