City Seeks Public Input for Donkey Creek Drainage Study

Open House Scheduled for Thursday, June 27

The City of Gillette is taking proactive steps to address flood mitigation in the Donkey Creek watershed and seeks community input in the development of a master drainage plan for the area. Partnering with WWC Engineering, the City aims to identify and develop preliminary designs, cost estimates, and project prioritization for up to ten flood mitigation projects along the creek.

Community members are invited to participate in the development of the plan through a web-based survey and a public open house event. The survey is designed to gather insights, concerns, and suggestions about flooding and drainage issues within the Donkey Creek watershed. A public open house is scheduled for Thursday, June 27, 2024, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Tech Center at Gillette College, located at 3251 S 4-J Road in Gillette. Community members will have the opportunity to share experiences and propose potential solutions to tackle flooding challenges in the city limits. Light refreshments will be served.
