The City of Gillette is seeking public participation in its Dalbey Park Improvements Study. A public open house will be held on Wednesday, October 9, 2024, from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. in the Wyoming Room of the Campbell County Public Library, located at 2101 S. 4J Road in Gillette.

The City is developing a master improvements study to guide future design and improvement efforts at Dalbey Memorial Park. Topics being considered in the study include water quality and recreation opportunities in the Fishing Lake, floodplain mitigation, the potential extension of Sinclair Drive and its impacts to the park, and evaluation of current and future public facility needs.

In addition to the open house event, community members are invited to participate in the development of the study through an online survey. 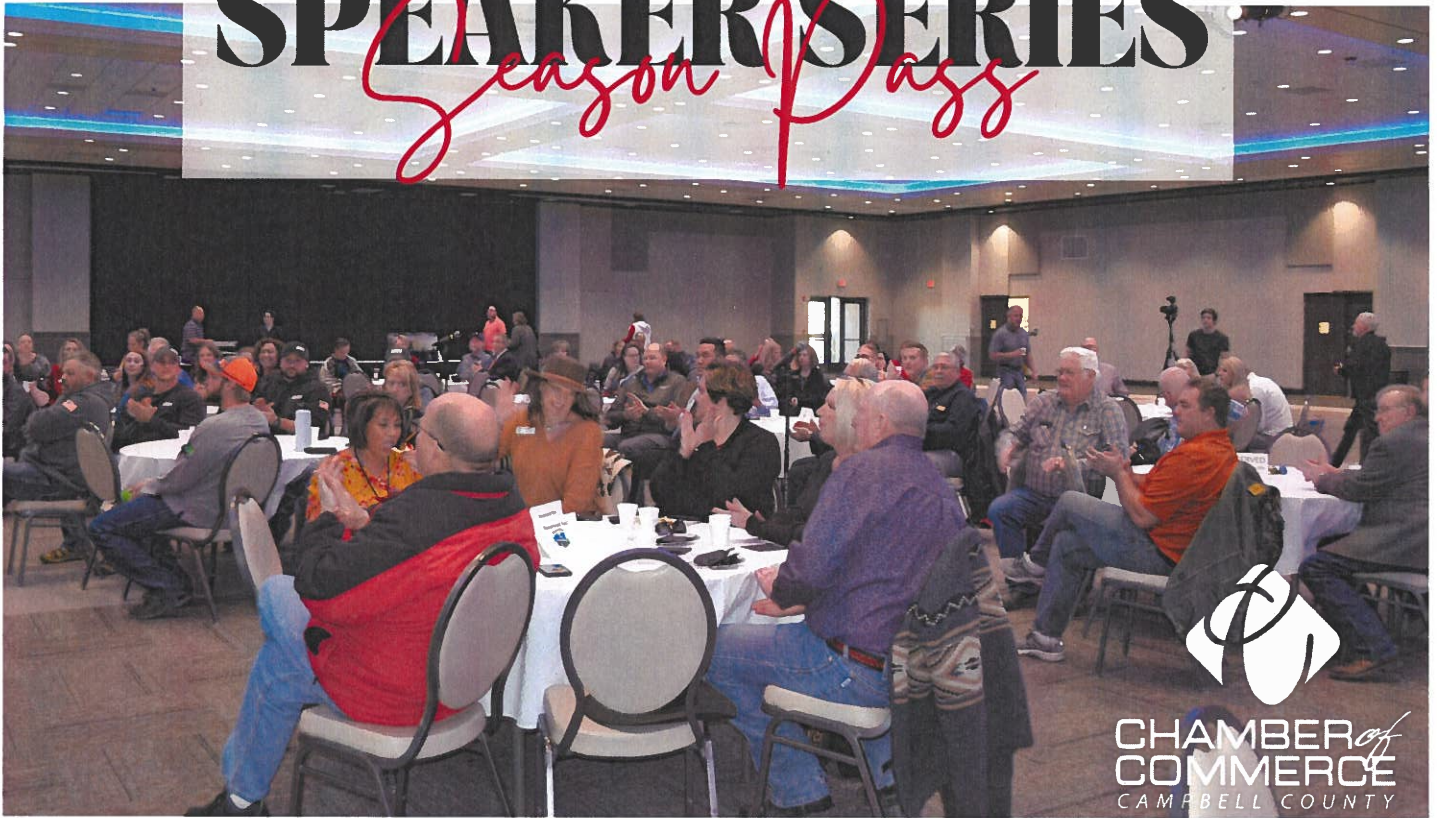
