
Do you have a smoke detector near where you sleep? Does it work? If not, ask your mom or dad to put up a smoke detector near the bedrooms and make sure it works.















Do the electrical outlets in your home have too many cords? Ask your mom or dad to check that the wires are not cracked or frayed.
