Thank you for submitting the City of Gillette's (Gillette) Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) to the Western Area Power Administration (WAPA). The IRP has been reviewed and approved and will be effective until July 1, 2025. Data from WAPA's customers will be consolidated and included in an annual report provided to Congress and others summarizing customers' accomplishments in fulfilling the requirements of the Energy Policy Act of 1992.

Section 905.23 of EPAMP as amended effective July 21, 2008, facilitates public review of customers' IRPs by requiring that a customer's IRP be posted on its publicly available website or on WAPA's website. In order to comply with EPAMP's IRP posting requirement, Gillette must either post its WAPA-approved IRP on its public website or provide WAPA with a PDF version for WAPA to post on its website.
